The Holiday Season is upon us! A Time for celebrations and gift giving! Have you ever wondered what to do when offered an invitation or gift?



The Code of Ethics prohibits Tribal Officials from soliciting or accepting anything of value that could have a substantial and improper influence on the performance of duties.



The rules of procedure provide guidance on Gift Giving and Receiving. Nominal or inexpensive gifts such as a coffee mug, tin of popcorn, or a t-shirt are not considered substantial. These types of minor gifts are not prohibited. Athough you may still choose to decline them to avoid even the appearance of impropriety.
