Risk of Interpersonal Misconduct

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The Ethics and Compliance Initiative provides statistics on workplace conduct based on global research and surveys.

Below are statistics on interpersonal misconduct.

28% of employees have observed at least one incident of abusive behavior, sexual harrasment, or discrimination.

62% said the behavior was one of several incidents or was part of an ongoing pattern of misconduct.

61% indicated that the interpersonal conduct was very serious or serious.

Factors associated with higher rates of Misconduct

- periods of organizational turbulence
- lack of reinforcement for following the rules
